- plan, document, and sub folio inquiries
- lots created
- lease information
- water access licence inquiries
- ▶ Electronic Notice of Sale (eNOS).

1.1 Search tips

Our NSW land search screens share common elements to simplify searches.

2 Title and Water Access Licence (WAL) searches

2.1 Title or WAL search

A title search produces the current title details such as:

- land description
- owner
- dealings.

View a sample title result.

Water access licences (WAL) in NSW define the access rights that the holder has for obtaining water from a water course. You can order WALs in the same way as titles.

The WAL Register provides a record of every licence in NSW. NSW Land Registry Services maintains the register on behalf of the minister administering the *Water Management Act 2000* (NSW).

The WAL search produces the current WAL details such as:

- share component (volume)
- extraction component
- water source
- expiry date
- conditions.

The WAL folio also shows:

- current ownership details
- mortgages, charges and related information
- nominated works approval number.

2.2 Prior title or WAL search

A prior title search lists prior references for the title or WAL reference you enter. Prior references will return for titles or WALs that are:

- current
- fully cancelled
- part cancelled (that is, cancelled with remaining residue).

View a sample prior title search result and a sample prior WAL search result.

2.3 Historical title or WAL search

A historical title search lists the amendments to a computer folio/title, including dealings and/or previous titles.

View a sample historical title search result.

A historical WAL search lists:

- transfers of ownership
- mortgages
- charges
- caveats
- related transactions.

You need to search all transactions registered on the WAL folio to establish if they're legal and form an unbroken 'chain of title'. The historical WAL search provides the list of transactions.

The search contains information on WALs since they were integrated into the computer folios on 1 July 2004.

2.4 How to complete a title or WAL search

1. To search for a title or WAL (including prior or historical), on the search details input screen, provide your title or WAL reference, your reference, and select **\$ Search \$**.



2.5 Cancelled titles

If you enter a title reference for a cancelled title, the results page will include a **More Info** link.

- 1. Click the link to display the search summary, which will provide details of the new title reference.
- 2. No charges will apply up to this point. You can proceed to either:
 - a) purchase the cancelled title
 - b) search on the new title reference details.



3 Land information searches

3.1 Street address by title reference

This search allows you to find a property address with a title reference. View a <u>sample street address</u> by title reference search result.


3.2 Street address search

This search will return the title reference for the street address you enter. The title reference will have one of the following formats:

- for a deposited plan (lot/plan for example, 20/20424, or lot/section/plan for example, 12/55/700123)
- 2. for a strata plan (CP/SPxxxxx for example, CP/SP12345).

View a sample street address search result.

1. On the search details input page, provide your reference, address details and search.



Note: The suburb is the baseline for this search. Once you enter a valid suburb, a list of related streets will display.

You should enter at least the first two letters of the suburb or street and use the links to assist with entries.

- 2. Your search will proceed to a results page. Select **Print** to save a copy of your result.
- 3. To proceed to order a title or historical title search, select the relevant links in your result.

3.3 Owner or lessee inquiry

An owner or lessee inquiry will provide the following details, where available:

- registered name
- locality
- title or Water Access Licence (WAL) reference
- acquired dealing
- corresponding title or WAL references.

From this list, you can select results to obtain a copy of the relevant title or WAL. Your search results can include the following automated or manual Torrens titles:

- current
- partly
- fully cancelled.


You won't receive details for old system titles. View a sample owner or lessee inquiry.

- 2. Provide your reference, name details, business purpose and complete the declaration. Then, select **\$ Search \$**.



3.4 Lots created search

A lots created search lists all lots within a plan. View a sample lots created search result.

 On the search details input screen, provide the plan type, number and your reference. Then, select Search.

3.5 Plan inquiry

A plan inquiry provides details on deposited plans (DP) and strata plans (SP) that have been lodged in the Integrated Titling System (ITS). A plan inquiry result will show, where available:

- plan number and plan category
- plan purpose and title system
- lot numbers
- number of sheets in the plan
- registration date of the plan
- strata development statements
- strata development contracts
- developer by-laws
- type of model by-laws (for example, commercial/retail, residential, industrial, mixed use and other as defined in the strata legislation)
- number of s88B easements (S = single, M = multiple or a number 1, 2, 3)
- number of s88B releases (S = single, M = multiple or a number 1, 2, 3).

The plan inquiry can also show the following:

Community plan associated documents

- Management statement
- Development contracts
- Surveyor name and reference


Council approval details

- Council name
- ▶ An indicator (*) if the council has changed since plan registration
- Approval date
- Approval number
- Plan parish and country

3.6 Document inquiry

A document inquiry provides details on documents that have been lodged in the Integrated Titling System (ITS). Depending on the document type, your result will contain a subset of the following:

- document number and type
- document status and date
- lodgement date and lodging party
- delivery party
- bundle (post-receipt number)
- lodging party reference
- lodgement invoice number
- review or re-lodge due date of the document

- document numbers within case
- titles affecting document
- whether the document was granted or refused urgency (only applies to plans and primary applications)
- whether the document was lodged electronically via ePlan (only applies to plans).



3.7 Sub folio inquiry

A sub folio inquiry allows you to search for the details of life estates and share titles using a base title reference. By entering a base title reference, you'll receive a list of related sub folio lots as well as their status and share details.

Sub folios consist of a lot/DP (or lot/section/DP or lot/SP) identifier followed by one or more letters. For example, a sub folio may be 100/20002A. Suffixes display at the end of share titles to uniquely identify each share in a sub folio.



Note: Base title references are either:

- lot in a deposited plan (for example, 1/12)
- lot in a strata plan (for example, 1/SP12345).

You can't search the following title formats:

- volume and folio references corresponding to either manual or auto-consolidated titles, for example, 12345-123
- common property in strata schemes, for example, CP/SP12345
- community property within lot 1 in community plans (that is, DPs in the range 270001 – 280000), for example, 1/270123
- precinct property within lot 1 in precinct plans (that is, DPs in the range 280001 285000), for example, 1/280123
- neighbourhood property within Lot 1 in neighbourhood plans (that is, DPs in the range 285001 – 300000), for example, 1/285123
- water access licences, for example, WAL123.


4 Imaged documents

Scanned images of titles, plans and dealings are available to order via the imaged documents search. Most documents are available online within minutes, in PDF format.

Some older documents have not yet been scanned, but you can still order and receive them online. These older non-imaged documents get manually scanned and generally take only a few hours, during business hours, to return online.

View a sample:

- imaged dealing
- imaged deposited plan
- imaged strata plan.
- On the search details input screen, provide your reference, document type and number, and select Search.



Your search will proceed to a browse screen. Select the documents you'd like to purchase and click \$ Search \$ to proceed with your order. 3. Your search will proceed to a results page. 5 Lease information searches

Our lease information searches provide details on lease folios for commercial complexes.

Note: Head title references must conform to one of the following formats:

Criteria Example

Lot in a deposited plan 1/1023456

Lot in a section in a deposited plan 1234/5678/123456

Lot in a strata plan 1/SP12345

Share title sub folio 1/123A

Volume and folio reference corresponding to an auto-consolidated title

5.1 Lease premises index search

This search identifies a list of lease folios for commercial complexes of interest, including:

- shopping centres
- retirement villages
- office complexes.

You'll receive the following details in a browse list from a search:

- commercial complex name and address/locality (if available)
- complex head title(s) reference
- associated Lease Folio (LF) (lot/LF number)
- premises description
- lease folio status.

5.2 Lease folio data extract report

The lease folio data extract report provides comprehensive lease folio data relating to commercial lease complexes (shopping centres, retirement villages and office complexes).

You'll receive a list of lease folios relating to the commercial complex with the following details:

- commercial complex name and address/locality (if available)
- complex head title reference(s)
- lease folio(s)
- premises description
- dealing (if no current lease on the title exists, the report will indicate this)
- registration date
- name(s) of lessee/mortgagee(s)
- lease expiry date
- information about any sub-lease, variation of lease or change of lessee/mortgagee's name.

5.3 Lease extract caveats and other dealings report

The lease extract caveats and other dealings report complements the lease folio data extract report. However, it provides additional specialised lease folio information related to the commercial complex including:

- caveats
- writs
- orders of court
- unregistered dealings.

You'll receive a list of lease folios relating to the commercial complex with the following details:

- commercial complex name and address/locality (if available)
- complex head title reference(s)
- lease folio(s)
- premises description
- dealing (if no current lease on the title exists, the report will indicate this)
- registration date
- lodged date of the lease
- name(s) of the caveator(s)



The CT location inquiry – Water Access Licence (WAL) provides you with the following information:

- current edition number
- last delivery (physical location) details.

Note: The Real Property Amendment (Certificates of Title) Act 2021 (NSW) abolished paper certificates of title (CT). For CTs, real property title reference information retrieved through the location inquiry should not be relied upon without conducting further checks.

For CTs:

- Physical delivery and controlling party information are now redundant.
- Edition number of the CT may not be a true sign of a transaction on the Folio of the Register.

Information provided about WALs in this search is unaffected and remains current.

6.2 Certificate Authentication Code (CAC) inquiry - WAL

Anyone with a WAL can use the CAC to verify:

- details match those of the latest edition issued
- it is likely to be genuine.

The CAC inquiry will assist to verify the authenticity of the WAL by providing a result stating one of the following:

- Code is authenticated and okay.
- Code entered for that licence reference matched successfully with the licence details you provided.
- Information you entered doesn't match the details held for this licence reference.
- Licence details are okay, but the code doesn't match.
- Daily code check limit exceeded.

Verification requests against the same WAL reference are limited to ten per day to prevent hacking attacks.

Note: The Real Property Amendment (Certificates of Title) Act 2021 abolished paper certificates of title (CT). For CTs, CACs no longer have valid verification.

Information provided about WALs in this search is unaffected and remains current.

7 Electronic Notice of Sale (eNOS)

NSW Land Registry Services (NSW LRS) uses the data on notices of sale to notify relevant rating authorities (for example, local council and water authorities) of a change in ownership or name of owner(s).

You can only use eNOS for Torrens title properties. For transactions that change owners for old system land, you'll need a paper notice of sale form to lodge.

7.1 Create eNOS

- 1. To create an eNOS, on the details input screen, provide your reference, other required details, and select **Submit**.
- 2. You will proceed to a results summary, which will show your eNOS ID and passkey. Retain these details for your records and generate a summary eNOS report, if required.



8 Appendix 1 – title and water access licence references

8.1 Title reference

A title reference can be either a lot/(section)/plan or a volume and folio number, as shown by the following examples.

8.1.1 Lots/(section)/plan

The section number is optional, and each number is separated by a forward slash (/).

Scenario	Example
Lot 1 on deposited plan 23456	1/23456
Lot 7 Section 12 on deposited plan 6789	7/12/6789
Common property on strata plan 3456	CP/SP3456
Lot 23 on strata plan 3456	23/SP3456 or 23.3456
Lot 1 on strata plan	1/SP1 or 1.1

8.1.2 Volume/folio number

The volume and folio numbers are separated by a hyphen (-).

Scenario	Example
Volume number 1 on folio number 1	1-1
Volume number 1234 on folio number 12	1234-12

8.2 Water access licence

A water access licence reference consists of the characters 'WAL' followed by one to eight numbers (for example, WAL123 or WAL12345678).

9 Appendix 2 – searching by owner name or organisation

9.1 Owner name

- If you enter 'Mc' or 'Mac', the inquiry searches on both variations.
- If you enter an apostrophe (for example, 'O'Brien') the inquiry searches for names both with and without it.
- If you enter spaces (for example, 'Van Der Meer') the inquiry searches for names both with and without them.
- You can enter hyphenated names in full (for example, 'Smith-Jones' or 'Mary-Louise'). Or, you can enter them in part (for example, 'Smith' or 'Mary'). The inquiry routinely searches for hyphenated variations.

9.2 Organisation

- ▶ Don't use abbreviations such as 'P/L' or 'Pty Ltd'.
- If you're unsure of the exact name, leave out terms such as company, corporation or their abbreviations and replace them with a wildcard to find all variations.
- If you enter '&' or 'And', the inquiry searches on both variations.
- If you enter 'The', the inquiry searches for names with and without it.
- Include numbers if necessary (for example, 'The 123 Company').
- If the name includes punctuation or other special characters (such as a bullet point, comma, quotes or brackets) enter them, and the inquiry will search for names with and without them.

9.3 Wildcards

- You can use the wildcard '%' to broaden your search.
- They allow you to search for all entries that include a particular name or a string of letters.
- At least three characters must precede wildcards.
- If more than 500 matches return, you'll be prompted to refine your search criteria.

Wildcard example

A wildcard can represent one or more letters. For example, Robert% in the organisation name will provide the results Roberts, Robertson, Robertson & Sons, and so on.
